What types of Scholarships are there?

Who can apply for scholarships?

Everyone!

We have scholarships for

- ✓ High achieving students
- ✓ Location based students, eg Nhulunbuy, Alice Springs
- ✓ Financial hardship
- ✓ Course related scholarships, eg Engineering, IT
- ✓ Indigenous students
- ✓ Female students
- ✓ Higher Education students
- ✓ VET students
- ✓ International students

CDU Scholarships

- Provided by Organisations, Businesses, Individuals and the University
- All have different eligibility criteria
- Some contain paid work placements
- Most are cash payments which are paid into your bank account

How do I find out which scholarships I am eligible to apply for?

The [Scholarship Finder](#) will help identify these.

Lets have a quick look!

Remember...when applying

- ✓ Ensure you meet all the eligibility criteria before applying
- ✓ Apply using the online application form
- ✓ When you write your supporting statement ensure you address all the selection criteria
- ✓ Use the Scholarship Guide to give you hints on what to include in your supporting statement
- ✓ If you haven't studied previously at CDU, include a copy of your High School or University academic record
- ✓ Ensure you submit your application before 3pm Friday, 3 March 2017.

Can I Apply for More Than One Scholarship?

- Yes! We encourage you to apply for all scholarships you are eligible for.
- You can be awarded and hold up to two scholarships at a time.

Commonwealth Indigenous Scholarships

- Students must be of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Descent
- Must be enrolled as a full time student (30 credit points or more)
- Be able to demonstrate financial hardship
- Demonstrate the need to move (or have already had to move) to undertake Undergraduate studies with CDU

Non-CDU Scholarships

- There are links to external scholarships available on the Scholarships website – look for **‘Non CDU Scholarships’**
- Applications are to be sent directly to the external organisation who are providing the scholarship.
- You can find out whether or not you are eligible for these scholarships by following the link and reading the website of the organisation.
- You should also check with this organisation when the closing date for applications is.

Successful Recipients

Payments and Continuation

- All CDU payments are made into your bank account after the census date of each semester.
- For ongoing scholarships, you must maintain an appropriate academic record, which usually means a pass in at least 50% of the units you study. Some scholarships require you to pass all units and maintain a credit average.
- You will be reviewed each semester to check you are meeting all of the requirements of the scholarship.
- You must inform us of any change of circumstances!
